## From our Family Minister

Last Sunday we kicked off Contact Challenge 500. As a church we have been challenged to make at least 500 contacts before March 4, the day our Revival services start with Dr. Jim Britt. Contacts are really not that difficult to make. It is as simple as inviting a friend to church or calling someone who has been missing from Sunday School to tell them you missed them. I believe our community is full of people who would come to church if someone would just take the time to invite them.

Imagine you decided to plan a fishing trip. You went to the store and bought a nice pole and a great big tackle box. You purchased a hat and some lures. Then you went home and watched fishing shows all day to learn how to be the best fisherman you could be. You researched the lakes for the best spots to fish. You found out what kinds of fish are found in the ponds and rivers nearby and the best bait to use to catch them. You rented videos and even called expert pro fishermen to get their advice. The more you learned about fishing, the more excited you became. You would spend hours imagining what it would be like to hook the big one. You talked about fishing with your friends and they came to believe you were a really good fisherman. You went to the Bass Pro Shop and searched for all the right equipment. You even bought a boat. After all this, there was still one thing missing. In all your preparations you forgot to do one simple thing – go fishing.

You see, a real fisherman isn't the one who has collected the most knowledge about fishing. A real fisherman takes his pole to a lake or pond, baits his hook, and casts his line. He doesn't just do this once and go home. He does this over and over again. He may spend hours casting his line and waiting patiently for a bite. He may have to bait his hook several times before he catches anything. He may even spend all day at the lake and not catch a thing. But at least he has been fishing.

The Lord Jesus picked fisherman as some of His closest friends and disciples. They used nets instead of poles, but the idea was the same. He told them that if they would follow Him, He would make them fishers of men. Fortunately, they took Him at His word and followed. Today, we are challenged to continue in their footsteps as fishers of men. We cannot just spend all our time learning about how to fish. We have to take the time to leave our comfortable pews and go fishing. Inviting someone to church is a simple task. Sharing one's testimony and the plan of salvation isn't much harder. Opportunities abound if we keep our eyes open. That's what real fishers of men do.
